For what purposes we process your data and on what legal basis we do so

We collect, process, and use your personal data in compliance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG), as well as all other applicable laws, for the purpose of fulfilling the order or our contract and to meet our contractual and pre-contractual obligations.

The collection and processing of data is necessary for the execution of the contractual arrangement or the performance of the order and is based on:

- **Fulfillment of (pre-)contractual obligations (Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b GDPR):**
Processing your data is carried out to fulfill a contract or is necessary for pre-contractual obligations.
- **Compliance with legal obligations (Art. 6 para. 1 lit. c GDPR):**
Processing your data is required in order to comply with various legal obligations.

- **Consent (Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a GDPR):**
Processing is based on your consent, provided you have given us permission to process your data.
- **Protection of legitimate interests (Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f GDPR):**
Based on a balancing of interests, data processing may take place beyond the actual fulfillment of the contract in order to protect our or third parties' legitimate interests

Disclosure to Third Parties

Any disclosure of your necessary personal data to third parties will only occur insofar as it is required for the fulfillment of the contract, we are legally obliged to do so, or you have consented to it. It may occur that we process your personal data to comply with legal obligations, such as commercial and tax-related retention periods, or to provide information to authorities. Your data will be deleted as soon as it is no longer necessary for the purpose of processing and the statutory retention period has expired.

Data Transfer to Third Countries

No data transfer to third countries (countries outside the EU and the European Economic Area (EEA)) takes place.

Your Rights

You have the right at any time to access, rectify, delete, or restrict the processing of your stored data. You also have the right to object to the processing, the right to data portability, and the right to lodge a complaint in accordance with data protection law.

- **Right of Access pursuant to Art. 15 GDPR:**
You may request information about the data stored about you.
- **Right to Rectification pursuant to Art. 17 GDPR:**
You can request the correction of your data at any time.
- **Right to Erasure pursuant to Art. 16 GDPR:**
You can request the deletion of your data if we process it unlawfully or if your legitimate interests are disproportionately impaired. However, immediate deletion may be prevented by statutory retention obligations. Regardless, we will completely delete your data as soon as no statutory or contractual retention obligations remain.
- **Right to Restrict Processing (Art. 18 GDPR):**
You can request that we restrict the processing of your data.
- **Right to Data Portability:**
You can request that we provide you with your data—which you have provided to us—in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format, so that you can transfer it to another controller without hindrance from us.
- **Right to Object:**
If we process your data based on legitimate interests, you may object to this processing at any time. We will then no longer process your data unless we can demonstrate compelling

legitimate grounds for the processing that override your interests, rights, and freedoms, or the processing is necessary for the assertion, exercise, or defense of legal claims.

You may also object at any time, without providing any reasons, to the processing of your data for direct marketing purposes.

Furthermore, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time.
